

The Trans-Am became famous from this classic film that stars Burt Reynolds, Sally Field, Jerry Reed and Jackie Gleason.

The Throwback movie series are on the second Sunday of the month from April through September, which is the same time as the local Litchfield Pickers Market. The lineup of Throwback movies for 2019 also includes "The Sound of Music" on May 12<sup>th</sup>, "Dirty Harry" on June 9<sup>th</sup>, "Goonies" on July 14<sup>th</sup>, "Stand By Me" on August 11<sup>th</sup> and "Psycho" on September 8<sup>th</sup>.

The Pastrovich family purchased the iconic drive-in movie theater located on Historic Route 66 in Litchfield, Illinois in 2016, and have been widely praised for their care and efforts in keeping the Sky View open for business while at the same time having fun and drawing attention to nearby Route 66 attractions and communities.
